

2010 Advanced behaviour workshops

Dealing with aggressive behaviours

Participants will gain an understanding of how behaviours escalate to aggression or violence and identify common factors that trigger these behaviours. Participants will learn about approaches that can be used to manage these behaviours when they occur, and strategies to prevent these behaviours from occurring.

Tuesday 13th July 2010 from 9:30am – 12:30pm

Dementia Care and the Environment

Participants will gain an understanding of how the environment can cause behaviours in people with dementia and will learn about what makes an environment dementia friendly. Participants are required to bring photographs and floor plans of their care environments to this workshop so they can apply this knowledge.

Thursday 21st October 2010 from 9:30am – 12:30pm

Sexually inappropriate behaviours in dementia

This workshop will discuss intimacy and sexual issues for persons with dementia. Participants will be able to identify the specific approaches to assist promote sexual health for person with dementia and manage behaviours relating to sexuality.

Monday 9th August 2010 from 9:30am – 12:30pm

Wandering behaviours and management strategies

Participants will gain an understanding of the reasons why people with dementia wander, and practical strategies that can be used to allow a person with dementia to walk safely. This session will include a demonstration of how GPS tracking can be used.

Thursday 4th November 2010 from 9:30am – 12:30pm

Responding to changed behaviours in dementia care

Participants will gain an understanding of the different types of dementia related behaviours and the theories for why these behaviours occur. Participants will gain an understanding of treatment approaches, and how to practically apply these to improve the management of the behaviours of people with dementia in their care.

Tuesday 9th September 2010 from 9:30am – 12:30pm

Spaced Retrieval as a behaviour management tool

This workshop will provide participants with an understanding of how the Spaced Retrieval technique can be used to help people with dementia remember critical pieces of information to prevent behaviour problems.
