**ENROLLED NURSE AND MEDICATION MANAGEMENT
TRAINING JOINT ROUND 2010**

Dear Aged Care Service

I am writing to advise that the Department of Health and Ageing (the Department) is seeking applications from suitably experienced and qualified Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) to provide enrolled nurse training to personal care workers and enrolled nurse medication management training to currently enrolled nurses employed in eligible services.

Eligible services include residential services as well as multipurpose and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander flexible services.

Funding is available to deliver up to 550 enrolled nurse qualifications and medication management training places. There is a limit of one place per service. Additional funding is available for backfill, travel and accommodation for remote services. Eligibility for this funding will be determined by the Department.

Only RTOs can apply for funding to deliver this training. Individual aged care services and Approved Providers cannot apply directly for funding. However, eligible aged care services are encouraged to contact their preferred RTO should they be interested in applying for training under this funding round.

Applicant RTOs are being provided with *Approved Provider Training Endorsement* forms that require input from Approved Providers regarding the actual and desired numbers of training places required for each service managed by the Approved Provider. RTOs are required to submit *Approved Provider Training Endorsement* forms with their application to the Department. Applications close on 30 April 2010.
