As the Forward with Fairness changes unfold, the industrial landscape continues to change. Be sure to keep yourself informed on the Forward with Fairness package of laws as these will soon be coming into effect.

What will the new regime mean for your business? If you don't know the answer your business may suffer.

- **The National Employment Standards (NES)** – what are they and how do they differ from the current standard?

- **Right of Entry and union activity** – how does it differ from current law?
