**CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS**

The Residential Medication Management Review (RMMR) Program aims to improve the medication management for permanent residents of Australian Government funded aged care homes and promote quality use of medicines in Aged Care Homes.

The RMMR may be initiated by an accredited pharmacist or conducted by an accredited pharmacist in collaboration with a general practitioner.

The Australian Government Department of Health and Ageing has commissioned Campbell Research & Consulting to conduct an evaluation of the Program.

The Department is now seeking comment from organisations and individuals about the RMMR Program.

Submissions should address issues that will add value to the RMMR Program and should focus on:

1. Key benefits of the program for residents of Aged Care Homes
2. Barriers to and enablers of the program – especially identifying gaps in access
3. The current funding and service model
4. The range and type of quality use of medicine services provided under the RMMR Program.

All submissions should provide justification for comments and any recommendations made.
