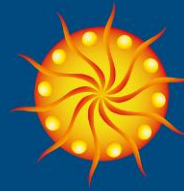

Purpose

The South Australian and Northern Territory Dementia Training Study Centre (SA & NT DTSC) is offering a maximum of 25 course subsidies to subsidise the cost of the **Dementia, Delirium & Depression** course to be offered as continuing education through Flinders University School of Nursing & Midwifery (FUSNM). This course will be conducted on-line for external students from 13 October 2008 to 30 January 2009.

Criteria

Course subsidies are available to health professionals and students from a variety of disciplines, including nurses, occupational and diversional therapists, physiotherapists, psychologists, social workers, and speech pathologists.

The allocation of subsidies will be made by the SA & NT Dementia Training Study Centre. Subsidies will be paid direct to the FUSNM.

Successful applicants will be required to register for the course using the FUSNM continuing education registration form (on the attached course brochure). Students will be required to attach their approved course subsidy application form and pay the balance of the course fee to FUSNM on registration.

Subsidies are not transferable to other courses. Course subsidies are funded by the Australian Government as part of the Dementia Training Study Centres for Health Professionals Project.

Amount

The amount of the subsidy will depend on whether the student is undertaking assessment.

For participants **not undertaking** assessment the course fee is \$530 (inc GST). The amount of the subsidy will be \$400 (inc GST). Successful subsidy applicants will be required to pay the balance of \$130 (inc GST), being the balance of the course registration fee for non-assessed participants.

For participants **undertaking** assessment the course fee is \$650 (inc GST). The amount of the subsidy will be \$550 (inc GST). Successful subsidy applicants will be required to pay the balance of \$100 (inc GST), being the balance of the course registration fee for assessed participants.

Application Process

2. The SA & NT DTSC will send a copy of approved application forms to successful applicants and will advise the FUSNM Accounts Officer of successful applicants.
3. Successful applicants are to register for the course with FUSNM and pay the balance of the course fee.

Closing date

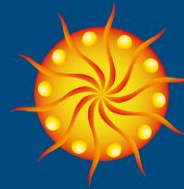
Applications must be received by the Director of the SA & NT DTSC by cob Friday, 12 September 2008. Due to limitations to the number of subsidies available, no consideration can be given to late applications.

The Centre will advise applicants of the outcome of their application by Friday, 19 September 2008 to allow time for students to register in the course by the course intake closing date of Friday, 26 September 2008.
