Indigo Vision hospital and aged care video surveillance

Bringing CCTV Cameras to you to view on an 'as required basis'

- ◆ Have cameras programmed to display only when there is something to see, making it easier to watch the correct cameras.
- ◆ Display video only when a corridor is occupied after hours or when a parent is wandering out of a door.

Allowing any PC workstation to be a viewing point

- ◆ Bringing the video to you on your PC instead of in a corner that is not watched.
- ◆ Intercom calls can be answered directly from any PC.
- ◆ Wandering patient alarms can be displayed with video of when the alarm triggered and where the patient is right now for verification.

High Definition TV resolution recording to give playback that is actually of use

Integrating wandering patient, out of bed alarms and call point alarms to the CCTV

- ◆ RFID tags can be tracked as part of a wandering patient system for statistics on the patient risk.
- ◆ A room call can automatically display the corridor the room is on, allowing a charge nurse to see that the call is being responded to.

Temporary Cameras

- ◆ A camera can be temporarily installed by maintenance with minimal effort to monitor a specific patient or area.

Intercom and PA System

- ◆ Any camera location can act as an intercom door station with pre-recorded messages to acknowledge the call.
- ◆ Cameos can be integrated to the PA system allowing announcements or pre-recorded messages to be played at designated times, on an alarm or in conjunction to the nurse call system.
